 TRAINING**

ET1 Continue to increase skill levels of local people by offering a range of vocational and non-vocational GPC, GC, Local colleges  
 programmes from the Glapwell Centre in partnership with local colleges and education providers.  
 ET2 Develop an IC suite within the Glapwell centre to provide structured IT training for the local BDC, GCA  
 community – to include entry level ICT courses, Use of the Internet & Provision of information on how  
 to keep children safe on the internet.  
 ET3 Work with the job Centre and other local providers to provide on line assistance for job seekers Job Centre, GC, GPC  
 including helping with CV building and on line job search.

**HEALTH&  
 WELLBEING**

HW1 Continue to encourage local people to use smoking cessation sessions at the Glapwell Centre PCT  
 HW2 Find funding to provide a small gym and instructor to provide supervised exercise sessions for all ages. GPC, GC, GCA  
 HW3 Find funding to develop healthy living sessions at the Glapwell Centre to include cooking low cost, low GPC, PCT, GC  
 fat meals. Also provide dietician and exercise support to those who want to lose weight/  
 HW5 Identify the numbers of older people in the area who may require a meals at home service & consider GC, BDC, GPC  
 establishing a local hot meals services for older people – linked to the Luncheon Club  
 HW7 Provide dance and exercise classes at the Glapwell Centre PCT, BDC, GC, GPC  
 Health Taster Days – Body MOT's etc Female only sessions – Gym and dance classes  
 HW10 Develop an annual schedule of programmes for the Glapwell Centre GC, GPC
